

ONE DAY TRIP 7.30AM-7.30PM

Five Rathas (Pancha Rathas) -**Mid-Morning**

Dakshina Chitra (12:15 PM - 3PM)

Spend about 1.5 to 2 hours exploring this cultural heritage museum. DakshinaChitra showcases traditional South Indian architecture, art, and crafts.



Arjuna's Penance & Krishna's Butterball

Explore Arjuna's Penance, a stunning open-air bas-relief with intricate carvings. Visit Krishna's Butterball, massive boulder perched precariously on a slope.



Lunch (12:15 PM - 1:00 PM)



Mahabalipuram Lighthouse

Climb the lighthouse for panoramic views of the town and the sea and Explore ancient cave temples and carvings nearby.



Muttukadu - Boating and Relaxation (3:30 PM)

Drive 10-15 minutes to Muttukadu for a boat ride or relaxing by the backwaters. Spend about an hour there.



Mahishasuramardini Cave Temple Marvel at this small but historically significant cave temple with intricate carvings of goddess Durga



Crocodile Bank (4:45 PM)

Visit the Madras Crocodile Bank, 15 minutes from Muttukadu, for an hour to explore the enclosures and conservation efforts. If available, visit the snake park and interactive sessions. Depart for the hotel around 5:30 PM.

MORNING



Shore Temple




Anna Centenary Library: One of Asia's largest libraries, located in Kotturpuram.
